On Site Learning Plan In Accordance with Executive Order 2020-51 *Arizona: Open for Learning*

Starting on Monday, Aug. 17th, CITY Center for Collaborative Learning will make available free limited spaces for students in need of a safe learning environment during regular school hours Monday through Friday.

The space will be available from 8:30 - 4:00 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. It will be available from 8:30 - 2:00 on Wednesday.

This space will follow strict social distancing guidelines, and additional safety and wellness protocols will be enforced. All students and staff in the building will be required to wear a mask and follow the mask policy.

Some combination of administrators, teachers, paraprofessionals, and support staff will be on hand to monitor students as they complete their remote learning assignments. Strategic support will be available.

Daily wellness checks will be required for all students before they are allowed to enter.

Breakfast and lunch will be available on site. Families who are not using the on site learning option may also pick up breakfast at lunch at our daily distribution site.

Weekly communication will be shared with families to determine student needs. All efforts will be made to provide academic, emotional, and technical supports to students to allow them to work successfully from home. Students who still need access to the limited onsite spaces in order to successfully access the remote learning curriculum will be asked to sign up in advance.
