Special Education Teacher

We are seeking a certified special education teacher to support students with individualized education plans (IEPs) to ensure academic success in radically inclusive general education classrooms. The position will serve as an inclusion specialist, working school-wide to support students and teachers.

Management of Individual Education Plans (IEPs)

- Work with a team to manage a caseload of 40-45 students with IEPs including required 3-year reevaluations
- Strategically plan, coordinate, and facilitate annual IEP team meetings with parent(s), student, and teachers for each student with an IEP to update progress and re-visit or revise student learning goals
- Provide ongoing professional development and accountability that ensures implementation of IEP goals, accommodations and modifications
- Use data informed processes to track student progress and for progress reporting
- Provide and oversee the implementation of specially designed instruction as outlined in IEP's

General Education Inclusion and Study Skills Planning, Teaching and Oversight

- Support all students in general education settings through co-planning and co-instructing and co-assessing with general education teachers
- Collaborate with a team of Support Services including an additional Special Education Teacher & Coordinator, two Education Assistants, contracted support services, student services director and Administration
- Plan and teach students with and without IEPs in Study Skills elective class
- Utilize positive behavioral support strategies
- Participate with teaching staff in collaborative professional development

- Embrace and integrate diversity, equity, and inclusionary practices

- Bachelor's degree (or higher) required
- Special education teacher certification
- Experience teaching or working in a school, supporting student academic success
- Demonstrated success as a collaborative professional
- Strong work ethic
- Demonstrated ability to independently manage high-quality reports and compliance deadlines
