Education Assistant/Academic Tutor Summary

We are seeking an Education Assistant to support high school students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) to ensure academic success with general education coursework. Provide inclusive support for students in general education classrooms and reteach concepts during study skills class. Work in close collaboration with the certified special education teacher and general education teachers to differentiate instruction.

Specific functions include:

- Assist with work completion and reteaching of concepts taught in general education courses, including all levels of high school math, science and humanities
- Provide accommodations and modifications as outlined in students' IEPs
- Work with students in general education classrooms, small groups and one-on-one
- Utilize positive behavioral support strategies and develop positive relationships with students and staff
- Participate with instructional staff in professional development
- Work collaboratively with general education teachers in co-planning and teaching to meet the needs of all learners
