### Position Summary: Math Teacher

We are seeking a full-time Math teacher with demonstrated background and interest in curriculum development, project-based learning, and differentiated instruction. The school's approach is to integrate local resources and/or issues from our city and region into the concepts and skills students learn.

### Specific functions include:

- Design, plan and implement a project-based Algebra II class for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Design, plan and implement two project-based Geometry classes of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Design, plan, and implement Math Support elective classes for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Collaborate and co-plan with other grade-level teachers for integrated units of instruction.
- Provide accommodations and modifications as outlined in students' IEPs or 504 Plans.
- Participate in professional development activities.
- Plan and facilitate an Advisory for approximately 10 students
