### **Special Education Teacher / Inclusion Specialist**

We are seeking a special education teacher for Paulo Freire Freedom School-Downtown (grades 6-8 with 78 students) to support students with individualized education plans (IEPs) to ensure academic success in general education classrooms. The position will serve as an inclusion specialist, working school-wide to support students and teachers.

Specific functions include:

- Help with and ensure implementation of IEP goals and accommodations
- Collect data on student goals
- Support all students in general education settings through co-planning and co-instructing and co-assessing with general education and special education teachers
- Supervise and collaborate with the special education assistant (City High School position only)
- Provide support to students in 'study skills' electives class
- Utilize positive behavioral support strategies
- Participate with teaching staff in collaborative professional development
- Serve as an advisor to mix-grade level students (with and without IEPs)

- Bachelor's degree (or higher) required
- Special education teacher certification
- Minimum of 3 years experience teaching or working in a school, supporting student academic success
- Demonstrated success as a collaborative professional
- Strong work ethic
