BACKGROUND: The University of Arizona College of Education, in partnership with CITY Center Collaborative for Learning, is developing a Tucson Regional Teacher Profession Development Institute/Collaborative. Tucson area districts and charter schools are partnering on this initiative, as well as Tucson Values Teachers, the Office of the Pima County Superintendent, Southern Arizona Association for the Education of Young Children, and a number of other stakeholders in the region.

GOALS: The goal of this professional learning initiative is to help educators find the best match to their professional development needs, and create new opportunities where needs not currently being met. We hope to better leverage our collective PD activities in the region, while elevating the professionalism of teaching. Currently, we are completing a needs and resource assessment (surveys and focus groups). **This event is designed for teachers to share their PD experiences and ideas, and will be a valuable part of the data collection.** From the data we collect, our goal is to work with local teachers and stakeholders to develop a plan for a Tucson Regional Teacher Professional Learning Institute/Collaborative.
